## Notable Cases

---

### Parker v MIB (2019)

In 2015 Mr Parker was the victim of a hit-and-run accident in which he suffered life-changing injuries. Martin advised in writing and in conference, and settled a complex Schedule of Loss including a claim for considerable future losses. The matter ultimately settled for a significant six-figure sum favourable to the Claimant.

### Successful for the Claimant in a claim under the SGA 1979 and CRA 2015 (2019)

Martin successfully represented the Claimant at trial before HHJ Owen QC. The case involved a significant dispute over expert evidence and the satisfactory quality of goods, as well as complex questions of mitigation.

## Reardon v Mango Engineering (2018)

The Defendant (through its insurer) contended that the claim for vehicle repairs was an abuse of process. Martin advised on prospects and successfully represented the Defendant at first instance, advised on appeal and was successful in having permission to appeal refused before HHJ Yelton. The case involved an extensive review of the law surrounding abuse of process, Henderson v Henderson and compromise, as well as issues of costs.
